# Respite at Kearney Children's Museum



The 1st Thursday of every month from 6:00-8:00 pm The Arc **member** children and their siblings are invited to a special time of discovery, creativity, and wonder at the Kearney Area Children's Museum.

This event is for children with physical or developmental disabilities ages 2-12 and siblings ages 2-10. This is a free time with minimum structure. If your child does not do well in these environments you may want to consider sending staff or an older sibling to help or an alternative activity for your child.

**Preregistration is required!** Supervision for the first 25 children only. If you wish for your children to attend these nights you must return the **registration form on page 3 and the \$5 fee per family** to The Arc as soon possible, slots will be filled in order of receipt.

If you register for a respite night but are unable to attend please notify the Arc at 308-237-4343 as soon as possible to allow other families the chance to attend. **Walk-ins will not be accepted, so RSVP ASAP.** Families who do not follow respite rules (i.e. picking up children by 8 pm) will be moved to wait list for future respite. Families who are not registered and show up for respite will be turned away. A staff member will confirm your registration.

### Peanut Butter Honey Truffles

### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1/4 cup oats
- 1/2 cup natural peanut butter
- 1/4 cup honey
- 1/2 tsp vanilla
- Pinch salt (
- 2-3 Tbsp dried shredded coconut

Pulse the oats in a blender for 30-45 seconds to a powdery flour.

In mixing bowl, stir peanut butter, honey, vanilla, salt and oat flour

Roll the peanut butter mixture into 1-inch balls.

Roll each ball in dried coconut to coat.

Place truffles in the refrigerator. Chill for at least 30 minutes.

Serve cold. Store truffles in the refrigerator.
