MARCH IS DISABILITY AWARENESS MONTH

Disability Awareness is key to establishing inclusion for people experiencing disabilities. Here are 8 ways to include people with disabilities.

- 1. Communicate that all people are valued, respected, and welcome.
- 2. Understand that disability has a wide nature and impacts most people by age, illness, or accident.
- 3. Create a plan to hire people with disabilities.
- 4. Refer to people respectfully and how they want.
- 5. Ensure communications are accessible.
- 6. Show people with disabilities in your images on your website and social media.
- 7. Share how your policies are inclusive.
- 8. Update facilities and events to make them more welcoming for people with disabilities.
